

## ESSENTIAL QUALIFICATIONS FOR DUVALL HOMES

Applicants must meet the following minimum criteria for **PERMANENT RESIDENCY** or enrollment in **ADULT DAY TRAINING**



### WHO WE SERVE

- Most persons diagnosed as ID/DD, with the exception of Asperger's
- Must be at least 22 years of age
- Duvall Homes is NOT licensed to care for persons with intense behaviors or mental health diagnosis
- Contact the Agency for Persons with Disabilities (APD) at [apd.myflorida.com](http://apd.myflorida.com) for placement referrals
- Duvall Homes does NOT offer supported living or employment services, or accept international referrals

### PRIVATE PAY FUNDING

- Parent or Family Member
- Guardian
- Trust Fund
- Social Security and Pensions, including Railroad and VA may be incorporated, but these alone will not cover all costs

### MEDICAID WAIVER FUNDING

- If not currently enrolled: Applicant must apply through APD at [apd.myflorida.com](http://apd.myflorida.com). (Lengthy process/Wait list.)
- Applicant is currently receiving Home and Community Based Medicaid Waiver Services (HCBS)
- Services do not transfer across states

### IS DUVALL HOMES A FIT FOR YOU?

- Individual is NOT diagnosed with intense behaviors or mental illness
- Individual is at least 22 years of age
- Funding can be provided through Private Pay accommodations, OR
- Individual is currently receiving HCBS, through which funding can be provided
- Individual is NOT seeking supported living or employment services

**IN ADDITION** to the residential fee, there are additional costs for Adult Day Training, medical copays, medications, personal allowance monies for clothing, activities, incontinence assistance/supplies, dental care, wheelchair repair and other services not covered by insurance.
